Evergreen Missionary Baptist Church established in DeQuincy in 1911

Missionary Baptist Church was the first Black church organized in DeQuincy in 1911 by Rev. Ambrose. Families who helped organize the early church were Dave Miller, Sr., the Stoudmires, and the Quillers.

The church was rebuilt in 1913 after being destroyed by a storm and again in 1958

Ministers who have served as pastors were Rev. Matthew Simmons (1914-1919), Rev. Groves (1919-1948) and Rev. Allen Gillespie (1948-1982). Rev. Willie Stevens was called to pastor the church in March, 1983. Evergreen is presently under the leader-ship of Pastor James B. Harris. Pastor Harris was called to the church in October, 1998.

Evergreen is presently a member of the New Light Association and the National Baptist Convention America, Inc.

The church has served as an outreach center, a collection point for food, clothing and other goods to be distributed to needy families of the

community. This church was also the first school for Blacks as well as a meeting place for civic leaders and members of the community. The local chapter of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) continue to meet monthly at the church.
