B Bible Authority - We do not just believe the Bible contains the word of God, we believe the Bible *IS* the word of God prescribed for us in the King James Version.

A Autonomy - We believe the local New Testament church is independent and self governing. We have the Bible as our guide and missions as our goal to the glory of Jesus Christ.

P Priesthood of Believers - We are a priesthood together in unity of service to the Lord. *"But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of Him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light."* 1 Peter 2:9

T Two Ordinances -
Baptism: After a person has placed their faith in Christ, then they are baptized by immersion as a picture of the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ. Not to be saved, but to show what Jesus did for us in salvation.

Lord's Prayer: As baptism pictures the gospel, so does the Lord's Supper. The bread represents His body and wine represents His blood. This we partake of in remembrance of what Jesus did for us.

I Individual Soul Liberty - Every believer has to make their own decisions in serving Christ. Each believer has free will and liberty to serve Him, love Him, and do what He has called each to do.

S Saved First - A believer is saved first, followed by baptism by immersion, and then becomes a member of the church.

T Two Offices -
Pastor: Undershepherd or Overseer
Deacons: Servants and helpers of the Pastor and servants to widows and others in local churches.

S Security in Salvation - We believe there is security in salvation, but this does not give us freedom to sin. Believers are saved by His grace and through His blood, He is able to keep them saved. *"What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound?" Romans 6:1*
